This number being 3 votes in excess of the number of Electors present the Chairman of the meeting, in conformity with the School Law, ordered the tellers to replace the ballots in the ballot box and at random withdraw there from 3 ballots and destroy them. The tellers reported having destroyed the 3 ballots and as a result of the recount it was announced that 255 votes had been polled with the results as hereafter noted."
